Shalom Church (City of Peace) Next Generation In Training (NGIT) Lesson Topics <u>August</u>

Goal for the Month:

As a new school year begins, and our students make ready to face new academic and social challenges, the goal of our lessons is two fold: (1) First, we intend to assure our students that God has and will give us all we need to succeed in school; (2) Second, we intend to assure them that, as children of God, God has given them the power to be a positive influence wherever they go. In other words, as followers of Jesus Christ, we are the salt of the earth and the light of the world.

As we carry out these intensions, we will address questions like:

- What is life look like for a follower of Jesus?
- How can we be "salt" while at home, at school and other places in community?
- What purpose(s) does salt serve? What are we empowered to do in community?
- How can we be "light" while at home, at school and other places in community? What purpose(s) does light serve?
- In his famous Sermon on the Mount, Jesus calls us to enter life through the "narrow gate." What does it mean to enter life through the "narrow gate?"

Key Terms: Influence, Hospitality, Disciple, Church, God, Jesus, Holy Spirit

Influence – to shape or cause something or someone to be and act a particular kind of way; to lead something or someone in a certain direction; EXAMPLE: As followers of Jesus Christ, we have been blessed with the power to influence others in a positive way. We have the power to influence others to follow Jesus. We have the power to influence others to listen and pay attention in class.

Hospitality – kind service to the other

Disciple – a learner and a follower of Jesus Christ; EXAMPLE: We can be disciples of Jesus Christ.

Church – The word "church" comes from the Greek "ekklesia" which means "gathering" or "assembly." Therefore, the church is the gathering of the believers who come together to participate in fellowship with one another as they worship God.

God – God is the creator of all people, the world, the universe, and everything seen and unseen.

Jesus – Jesus is the Son of God; He is one with God, and He was sent here for our salvation.

Holy Spirit – He is called the "Promise of the Father", given by Christ as a gift to the Church, to empower the Church for service to God, to place God's love in our hearts. We are to grow in our experience of the Holy Spirit for the rest of our lives.
